

ADJOURN

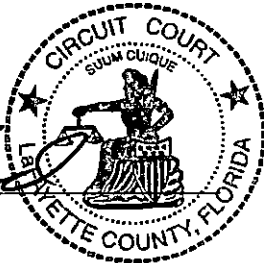
On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Pridgeon, the board voted unanimously to adjourn.





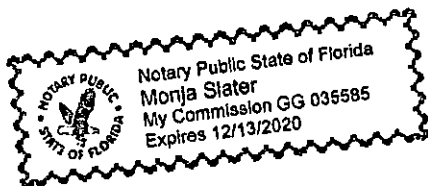
