LAFAYETTE COUNTY SHERIFF

Brian Lamb, the Lafayette County Sheriff briefed the Board on his fiscal year 2022 budget requests. He is requesting an increase to add two positions. The Sheriff's Office is struggling to comply with the Police Reform Act, which is increasing requirements in training and reporting. The Board took this under advisement.

The Board discussed issues related to salaries, the Fire Department and other miscellaneous items. Marty Tompkins briefed the Board on the pay of paramedics with Emergency Medical Services. Keesha Fundora discussed various issues pertaining to the new budget.
