

REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 13, 2021

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4 (by phone); Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

SCOTT SADLER

On a motion by Mrs. Walker and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve allowing Florida Gas Transmission the use of the right-of-way on NE Thalia Road to run a ground bed for a gas pipeline.

DRIVEWAY PERMIT APPLICATION AND UPDATED FEES

Garret Land, Lafayette County Building Inspector, and Scott Sadler, Lafayette County Public Works Director, discussed the updated Driveway Permit Application and fee schedule with the Board. They submitted information for the Board to review and approve. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the application presented.

APPROVE A SUB-RECIPIENT ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT FOR THE SHIP PROGRAM

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve a Sub-Recipient Administration Agreement with the Suwannee River Economic Council, Inc. for the Lafayette County SHIP Program.

On a motion by Mrs. Walker and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve a Funding Agreement with Meridian Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. for fiscal year 2022.

APPROVE THE NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT ROLL

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the fiscal year 2022 Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll for the Tax Collector's Office.

APPROVE THE E911 RURAL COUNTY GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the E911 Rural County Grant Program Application.

IDLE SPEED SIGNS FOR LAFAYETTE COUNTY BOAT RAMPS

The Board discussed possibly putting up Idle Speed Signs at the County Boat Ramps, per an email request from a citizen. The Board asked the Clerk to contact the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission about what could be done about this and then re-visit the issue at a later meeting.

COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR LAFAYETTE COUNTY

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to continue the COVID-19 State of Emergency for Lafayette County.

Emergency 911 Fund - \$2,490.79

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn.

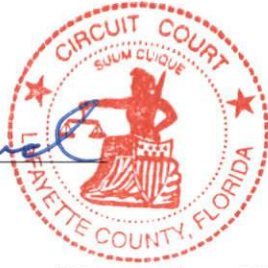
